Qualifying Charitable Organization

Contributions to a Qualifying Charitable Organization (QCO)
You can claim either the QCO or the QFCO, or both, in the same taxable year, and you do not need to itemize your deductions to receive the credits.

Foster Care Credit

Contributions to a Qualifying Foster Care Organization (QFCO)
You can claim either the QCO or the QFCO, or both, in the same taxable year, and you do not need to itemize your deductions to receive the credits.

Military Family Relief Credit

Donation to the Military Family Relief Fund
Arizona only approves the first \$1 million in donations as credits. The fund typically fills up by early December, so be sure to mail your donation in as soon as possible.

Public School Credit

Contributions Made of Fees Paid to Public Schools
You can claim all three education credits in the same year even if you don't have a child in school

Private School Tuition Credit

Contributions to Private School Tuition Organizations
Your private school tuition donation must go to a tuition organization that provides scholarships or grants to qualified private schools.

Certified School Tuition Credit

Contributions to Certified School Tuition Organizations
To claim this credit, you must first donate the maximum amount allowed to a private school tuition organization (donations that benefit your child/dependent wont qualify)
